Abstract

Two British economic geographers present a critical assessment of the development of the Novgorod region in the 1990s, questioning some of the practices employed by Novgorod Oblast Governor Mikhail Prusak to strengthen his political position within the region and to implement an economic development strategy. The paper reviews economic policies of the Regional Administration during and after the Russian financial crisis of August-September 1998, which serve to illustrate the close linkages between regional policies and the national economic environment.
