





South-East Asia (SEA) is particularly vulnerable to this problem, as the region's coastal ecosystems are highly productive and support the livelihoods of millions of people. This policy brief examines the threats to SEA's marine ecosystems from ocean acidification and provides recommendations for safeguarding these ecosystems.

Ocean Acidification in South-East Asia

The ocean absorbs an average of 25 billion tonnes of CO₂ annually, leading to a decrease in pH and an increase in acidity. This process is known as ocean acidification. The rate of acidification is increasing rapidly, and it is expected to reach levels that will threaten the survival of many marine organisms by the year 2100. SEA is particularly vulnerable to this problem, as the region's coastal ecosystems are highly productive and support the livelihoods of millions of people. 


