## Abstract

A new type of wallpaper has been developed which can cut fuel consumption appreciably where radiant heating is used. Its commercial exploitation was not pursued because the benefits are much reduced by obstructing furniture and by unprotected door and window spaces—although that was before energy costs soared. The project was carried out at the UK Electricity Council's Research Centre at Capenhurst.
