ABSTRACT

This study explored financial challenges among students in pursuit of a social work degree. A total of 357 students (74% response rate) enrolled in either a BSW or MSW program responded to an anonymous survey. Findings revealed that about one third of participants reported a lack of awareness about the cost of the degree and received less financial aid support than they expected. Financial and educational hardships were common. The majority (76%) of participants had accumulated student loan debt, and levels of debt were much higher compared to a study published a decade earlier. Exploratory bivariate analyses revealed that student variables were associated with perceptions about debt, as well as experiences of financial and educational hardships.
