## Abstract

This paper examines the causality between export expansion and economic growth in China using data covering the period from 1979 to 2001. A model allowing for different orders of integration and cointegration is used to test for cointegration and the error correction mechanism. The results show that there is a long-run relationship between export expansion and economic growth in China. The error correction mechanism is also found to be significant. The findings suggest that export expansion has a positive impact on economic growth in China.
