- ² Marcucci and Johnstone ([2007](#)) differentiate between tuition fees and normal fees in that tuition fees should cover some fraction of the general costs of education, while normal fees cover the costs of noneducation goods and services. In the German case, such a clear cut distinction cannot be drawn.

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
