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SYNTHESIS OF BENZYLBORONATES VIA PALLADIUM-CATALYZED BORYLATION OF BENZYL HALIDES WITH PINACOLBORANE

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ABSTRACT

Various benzyl halides were borylated with pinacolborane in the presence of $i\text{-Pr}_2\text{NEt}$ and a catalytic amount of $\text{PdCl}_2(\text{PPh}_3)_2$ to afford the corresponding benzylboronates in good yields.

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
